The project

The project "Laboratory of New Migratory Narratives" aims to generate new migration narratives that promote the positive aspects of migration and the contributions that migrants and refugees make to European societies.

During the project's workshops we conducted a series of interviews with migrants in Sweden. The participants of the workshops developed a list of questions they were mostly interested in, but they were not obligatory for the respondents:

- When did you come to Sweden and why?
- Did you come alone or with your family?
- Did you receive any support from the Swedish state or other organisations (volunteers)?
- Did you get the opportunity to learn the Swedish language?
- Could you immediately start working in Sweden?
- How do you perceive the country in general in terms of reception of immigrants?
- What would be your advice for newly arrived persons, especially young? How to adapt in a new country in the best way?
